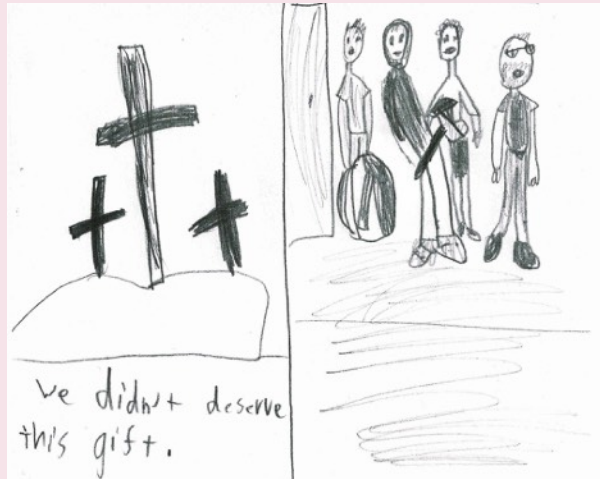

Week of Prayer - By Juliana Oliveti

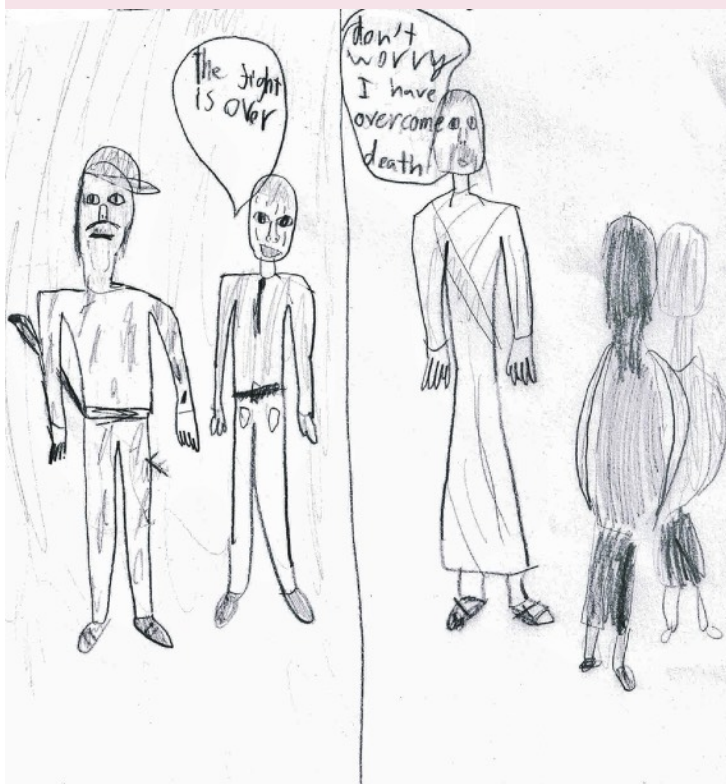
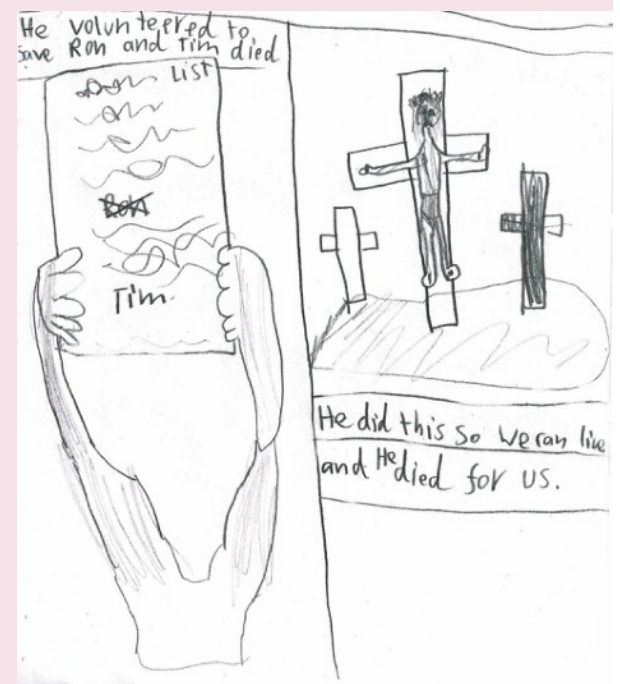
"On Monday we learned that Jesus came to save you and me from sin and the devil, like a lifeguard saves you if you are in trouble.
