Parking and Traffic: This is how you can help...

- Avoid Hazards: U-turns on the road are unsafe and prohibited. The blind corner and narrow space create a hazard. Choose safety over speed.
- Speed Limit: Please remember that the speed limit on the road leading into school is 40 km/h. Please slow down and prioritize the safety of our children.

By following these guidelines, we model responsible citizenship and create a calm, safe start and end to the school day. Your cooperation in being a "Peacemaker" on the road is greatly appreciated!
